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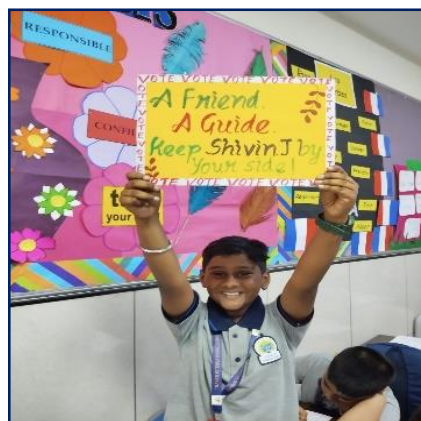
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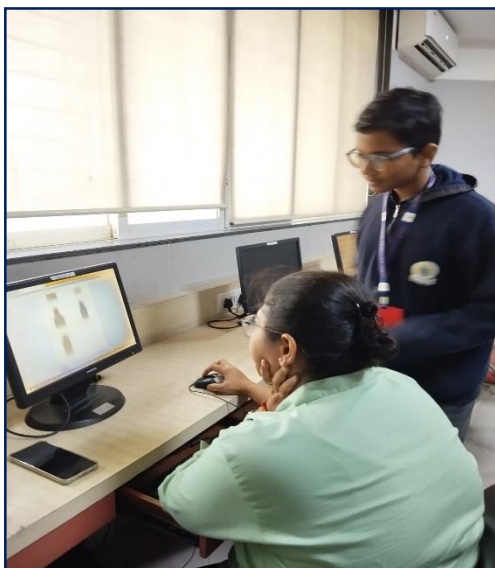
# COUNCIL ELECTION CAMPAIGN

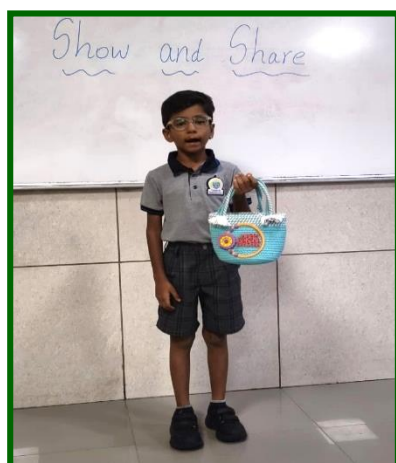
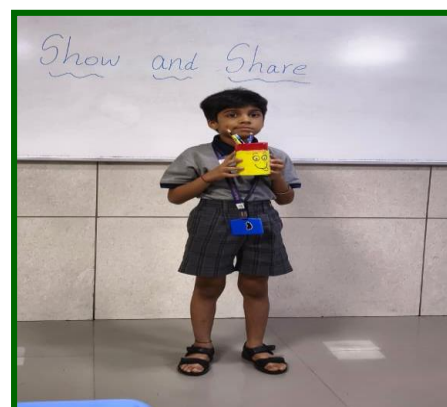
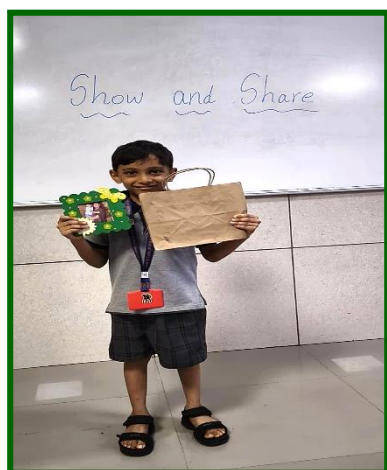


# ECO AWARENESS ACTIVITIES

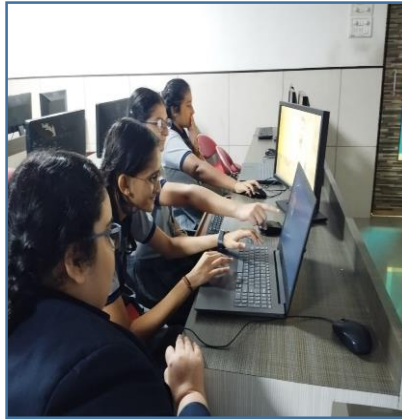
Competitions teach us to discover our talent, improve our confidence, enhance our creativity, and, most important thing is it teaches us that participation is what matters the most.

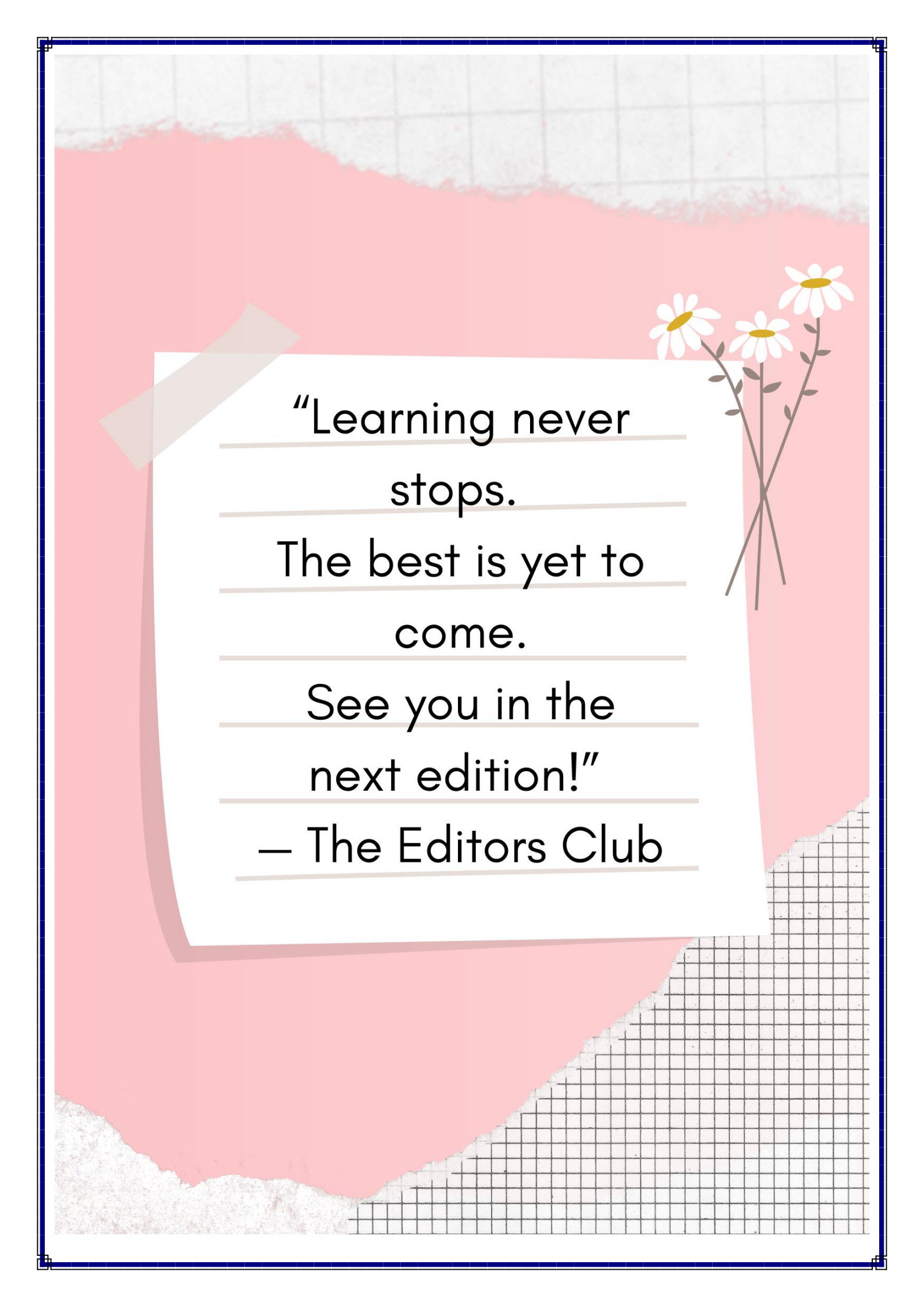
