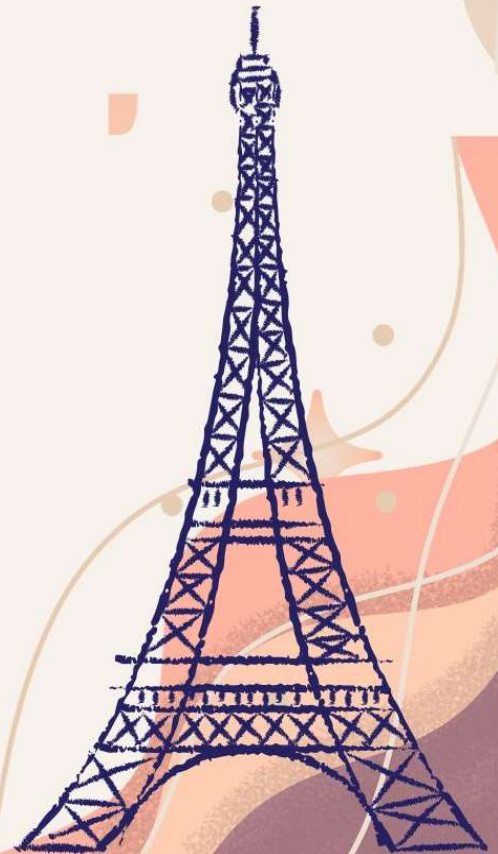

TOTE BAG MAKING

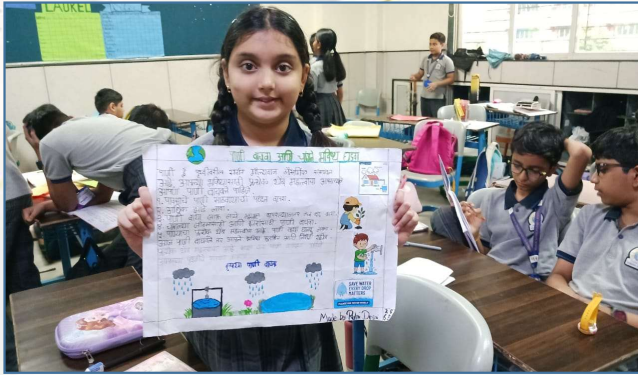

SDG ACTIVITIES:- CLIMATE CHANGE

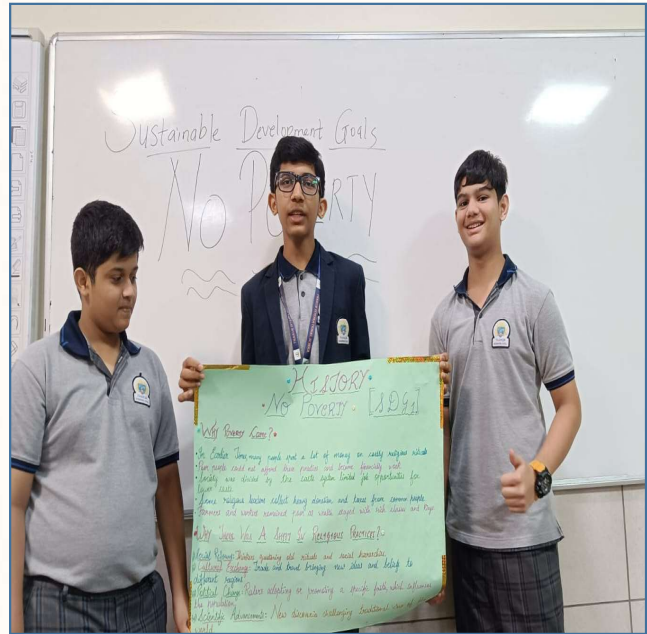
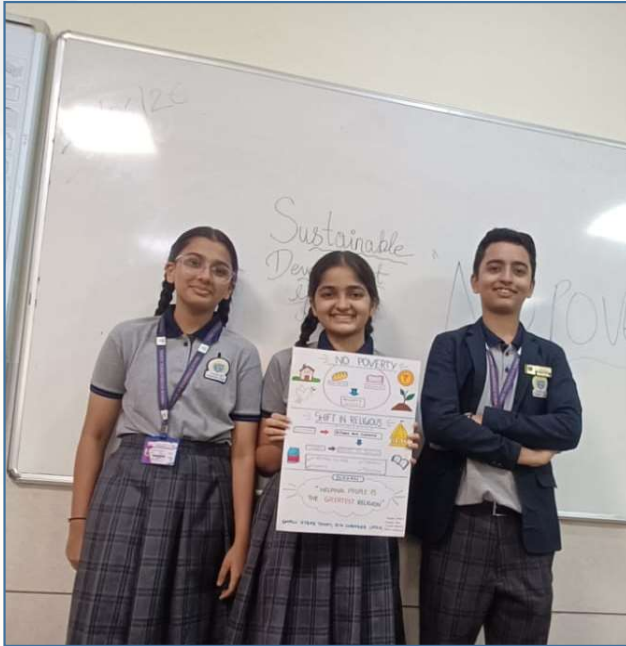
